Provide research and administrative support for the team including, but not limited to:

Donor Relations/Communications:

- Assist with acknowledgments for individuals, corporations and foundations
- Periodically assist with marathons by communicating with marathon team members via email, phone or THK Facebook group and thanking donors via Classy page
- Assist with thanking Charity Miles runners and donors via Classy page

Proposal writing support:

- Conduct literature review on public health trends affecting AFHK programs (i.e. the links between health and academic success, importance of parental involvement in school health, social-emotional learning, etc.) to support proposal submissions and development collateral
- Provide proofreading and copyediting support to concepts, grant proposals, pitch decks and other prospect collateral

Prospect Research:

- Assist with identifying, researching and qualifying prospects for institutional and individual major gift cultivation
- Assist with creating blue chip briefs of prospects
- Assist with entering prospects in Salesforce

Event/Campaign Support:

- Placing catering orders for luncheons and ordering promotional materials
- o Participate in team brainstorm sessions to develop concepts for partner activations

Administrative Support:

- Assist with gift entries for individuals, corporations and foundations
- o Assist with mailings of appeals, donor letters, event materials, etc.
- o Project management support using Asana and Salesforce
- Assist with account management by creating or editing funder deliverables documents
- o Attend team meetings, take notes, and share them with the team
