Action for Healthy Kids (AFHK) wants to support you with a **four-year District Partnership Grant valued at over \$465,000 of cash awards and in-kind products and services**. Tell Me More!

Through District Partnership Grants, AFHK establishes long-term partnerships with school districts and their schools that lead to lasting [family-school partnerships](#), positive impacts on children's health in body and in mind, and sustainable, systemic enhancements across multiple program areas. AFHK partners with districts for an initial four-year period to address three program areas: [ConnectEd](#), [NourishEd](#) and [EnergizEd](#). Partner districts receive cash and in-kind support from AFHK throughout the partnership. **The four-year value of the grant is over \$465,000 with \$65,000 as cash awards and \$400,000 of in-kind products and services.**

Eligibility

School districts located in and around the following communities are eligible to apply for a District Partnership Grant: Chicago, IL | Jacksonville, FL | Palm Beach, FL.

During the 2022-2023 School Year (Partnership Year 1), Partner Districts Receive:

- \$100,000 in AFHK in-kind support plus \$5,000 cash award to support of student and staff health and well-being.
- Analyses of district's health and wellness policies, and school-level implementation of policies and practices, with expert recommendations and support to enhance content, language, implementation and evaluation.
- Support in creation/maintenance/expansion of a District School Health Advisory Council to improve the health and well-being of students, families, and staff.
- Learning sessions, digital tools and resources, and technical assistance for district staff, school staff and families around key topics related to the Whole School, Whole Child, Whole Community (WSCC) model.
- An AFHK-hired Family Connector to support the development of family-school partnerships across the district and to provide additional in-depth support for up to 5 schools through learning sessions and ongoing coaching.
- Access to AFHK's ConnectEd Curriculum Package, a collection of lessons, activities and resources for PK-12 to enhance student social-emotional learning.
